


# The 70-Week & 2300-Day Time Prophecies



- a, b. Autumn 457BC, King Artaxerxes Longimanus commissions Ezra to restore the temple in Jerusalem and appoint magistrates to reinstate self-rule for Israel (Ezra 7:21-26). Rebuilding temple required 46yrs to complete (John 2:20), however, the wall and the streets required an additional 3years (Dan 9:25); all were complete 49 years later in 408BC
- c. Jesus is anointed Messiah through baptism of the Holy Spirit, during Fall 27AD (Dan 9:25; Mat 3:16, 17, Mark 1:15)
- d. Crucifixion of Jesus Christ in the middle of the 70<sup>th</sup> week: 1<sup>st</sup> month, 14<sup>th</sup> day at noon, Spring 31AD (Ex 12:1-6; John 19:14; Daniel 9:27)
- e. The stoning of Stephen, signaling the end of the 70-wk probationary period for the Nation of Israel [Jesus stands-up] (Acts 6:8-8:4; comp. Heb 1:3) and extending of the gospel message to the Gentiles (Daniel 9:24-27; Acts 7; 9:1-31)
- f. End of 1260yr reign of 1<sup>st</sup> desolating power (*the daily* - Paganism) over Literal Israel; Beginning of 1260yr reign of the 2<sup>nd</sup> desolating power (the Little Horn of Daniel 7:8, 24, 25) over Spiritual Israel; Beginning of the *Dark Ages*
- g. End of 1260 year reign of the 2<sup>nd</sup> desolating power (Papal Rome), resulting in the power receiving a deadly wound (Daniel 7:25; 11:35, 36; Revelation 13:3-8). This time marker signals the *First End of the* (1<sup>st</sup>) *Indignation* [end of scattering]; the beginning of the prophetic Time of the End (Dan 8:17, 11:35; 12:4, 9); era of first and second cleansing of *Romanism* from God's Covenant Church [from 1798-1844 (Dan 12:4; Rev. 17:8 - "and yet is")].
- h. End of the 2300 year prophecy; *Last End of the* (2<sup>nd</sup>) *Indignation* (Dan 8:19); year of the *Great Disappointment* prophesied in Revelation 10:8-11; 46 years after *First End of the Indignation* – era where God rebuilds and enters into covenant with His *End Time Remnant Church* [beginning of the final gathering]; beginning of the pre-advent, *Investigative Judgment* in heaven where Jesus as High Priest enters the Most Holy Place for the cleansing of the heavenly sanctuary (Leviticus 16; Daniel 7:9, 10; 8:14; Revelation 11:19; Malachi 3:1-4; 1 Pet 4:17)

Daniel Chapter 9 (KJV)

9:24 **Seventy weeks** are determined upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy.  
**= 70 Weeks**

9:25 Know therefore and understand, [that] from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the Messiah the Prince [shall be] **seven weeks, and threescore and two weeks**: the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublous times.

9:26 <sup>a</sup>And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for himself: <sup>b</sup>and the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary; <sup>c</sup>and the end thereof [shall be] with a flood, and unto the end of the war **desolations** are determined.  
**= 69 Weeks**

9:27 <sup>1a,b</sup>And he shall confirm the covenant with many **for one week**: and in the midst of the week <sup>2</sup>he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease. <sup>3,4</sup>and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make [it] desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate [desolator].  
**= + 1 Week**

**SUMMARY:** The verse first states that 70 prophetic weeks are cut-off, determined, numbered for the Nation of Israel (MENE). It then provides a summary of the events to take place within the spans of the 70-weeks.

Jesus **alone** fulfills the promises/prophecy (Gen 3:15)

1. Finish transgressions: (Isa 53:4-11; Heb 4:15, 16; Jude 1:24, 25)
2. Make an end of sins: (John 1:29, 19:30; Matt 27:50, 51; Heb 2:14; 9:12; 10:12-14)
3. Make reconciliation for iniquity: (Matt 20:28; Eph 1:3-7; 2 Cor 5:18-21; Heb 9:11, 12)
4. Bring in everlasting righteousness: (Matthew 3:15; 2 Cor 5:21; Heb 1:1-6)
5. Seal up visions & prophecy: (Gen 3:15; Deut 18:18, 19; Mark 1:15; John 5:39, 19:30; Luke 18:31, 24:25-27; Acts 1:15-20; Daniel 12:9)
6. Anoint the most Holy: (Hebrews 9:11, 12; 1 Kings 8:62-64; Revelation 1:12-18)

**DETAIL:** These verses repeat the details of the preceding verse with greater detail, expounding on the first 69 weeks of 70 weeks:

1. There will be 7+62=69 weeks of weeks (483years) from the decree (457BC) to rebuild the temple in Jerusalem, reinstating self-rule for the Nation of Israel, until Messiah the Prince
2. The word *Messiah* whose Latin translation is *Cristos* or Christ, means Anointed One. The event being referenced is Jesus' baptism when anointed by the Holy Spirit in the Fall of 27AD (Matt 3:16, 17)
3. **After** the 62-weeks (483yrs from the decree of 457BC) the following will occur:
  - a. Christ will be cut off or killed, but not for Himself but rather for you and me (Isa 53:4-12, John 3:16).
  - b. The destruction of Israel is foretold resulting in the desolation of the city, and the temple by the 1<sup>st</sup> desolator (pagan Rome). See Matt 22:7; 23:37-39; 24:1, 2, 15-20; Deuteronomy 28:49-57
  - c. A prediction of the rise of the 2<sup>nd</sup> desolator (papal Rome), coming in like a flood (Rev 12:6, 14,-17) is foretold and his continuation until the *determined* end of the time of scattering – First End of the Indignation (1798AD) (Daniel 11:31-36).

**DETAIL:** This verse provides clarity to the final week, the 70<sup>th</sup> week

1. <sup>1a</sup>Christ, coming to His own though they received Him not, confirms the last week of the 70-week prophecy with the Nation of Israel. (John 1:11; Matt 10:5, 6; 18:21, 22). <sup>1b</sup>Jesus also enters into covenant with a new spiritual house that He alone has built [after rejecting the earthly tabernacle and those who honor it more than its glory, Jesus Himself], namely the Christian church (Matt 23:37-24:2; 26:26-29; 1 Pet 2:4-10; 1 Cor. 3:9-17; Acts 1:5, 8; 2:1-4) Christ, the true Lamb of God (John 1:29) causes sacrifices and offerings to cease (Matt 27:51; Heb 10:9) in the middle of the week when crucified.
2. Because of the Nation of Israel's rejection of Christ (Deut 18:18,19; Luke 13:6-9; Matt 18:21, 22; Acts 28:17-29, Roman 9:1-3), and suppression of truth (Matt 28:11-15; Acts 4:13-22; 13:46) desolation (God's wrath) would befall them by the 1<sup>st</sup> desolator (pagan Rome)– 36yrs later in 70AD (Matt 22:7; 24:15-20; Lk 13:1-9)
3. Abominations would continue and abound (overspread) by the 2<sup>nd</sup> desolator (papal Rome), until they have been completed [until the determined time] and punishment is poured upon the desolator (papal Rome) at the appointed time - 1798AD (Luke 21:24; Rev 11:1, 2; see also Dan 11:31-36)
