being the *Anti-Type*, the true Lamb of God that takes away the sins of the world (John 1:29; Hebrews 9:12-14).

Natural followed by the Spiritual: Natural or literal events, people, or things, once presented, are often portrayed later in the Bible in a spiritual context. When seeking understanding of the spiritual [symbolic], we must first reflect upon the characteristics of the natural [literal]: "*And so it is written, The first man Adam was made a living soul; the last Adam (Jesus) [was made] a quickening spirit. Howbeit that [was] not first which is spiritual, but that which is natural; and afterward that which is spiritual.*" 1 Cor 15:45, 46

Triple Application of Prophecy: Prophetic truths are at times revealed in triplet sets, where the characteristics of the first two occurrences of a truth or an event shed light upon the fulfillment of the third event, or mathematically: event 1 + event 2 = event 3. The *Triple Application of Prophecy* principle, confirmed upon the "*testimony of two or three witnesses*", is seen in the following triplet sets:

or suggest the subject is on the same point of comparison to the other object (Hosea 12:10; Psalm 78:2; Daniel 7:17, 23, 24; Acts 10:9-16, 11:1-18). The Bible alone must be the interpreter of the symbols, imagery, and metaphors by means of the following methods of Bible analysis:

1. The Bible should be searched from cover-to-cover, "*line-upon-line, precept-upon-precept, here a little, there a little...*" to gain understanding of a topic. This method is called **Proof Texting**: Isaiah 28:9-13; Daniel 12:4
2. Unless explicitly stated by a verse, a conclusion should only be drawn if two or more verses confirm or agree upon a topic, thought, or idea: "*by the mouth of two or three witnesses every word shall be established*" – Genesis 41:32; Deut. 19:15; John 8:17; 2 Corinthians 13:1

Repeat & Enlarge: When God would have His people understand a critical message, He repeats the message through His prophets, often using different symbols. The first occurrence of the message typically is the most comprehensive. However, with each successive repetition additional details are incorporated, bringing added clarity and an expanded understanding of the message.

Types and Anti-types: A *type* is a representation, figure, or symbol of the original, called the *anti-type*. The earthly sanctuary was a *type*, or representation of the heavenly sanctuary. The actual sanctuary in heaven is called its *anti-type* (Hebrews 9:8, 9, 24). Similarly, every lamb, bull, goat, or dove that was sacrificed for the remission of sin was a *type*, or symbolic representation of Jesus Christ; Jesus himself

Summary Followed by Detail: Often, the Bible will provide a complete summary of an event or message, and immediately follow the summary with the details. For example, the Creation story is summarized in the first verse of Genesis chapter 1. The remaining verses of chapter 1 and the entirety of chapter 2 provide the details that expound upon that single verse.

Symbols, Imagery, Metaphors: The Bible utilizes symbols, imagery, and metaphors in prophecy to illustrate important truths. Symbols and Imagery describe a subject by an object or illustration. Metaphors liken a subject to another object
