
Rules [prerequisites] for Interpreting the Bible and Prophecy

- God's appointed agency in the world for spreading the gospel today is the Christian church
- The promises given to Ancient (natural) Israel apply to God's people, the church of Jesus Christ today (Adventism), Spiritual Israel (1 Corinthians 15:46)
- The examples given in the Bible (experiences of Ancient Israel) are for our admonition upon whom the ends of the world are come (1 Cor 10:1-6, 11)
- Figures sometimes have two or more different significations; as day is used in a figurative sense to represent three different periods of time. (Miller's rule #10)
 - When reading the promises to Israel in the Old Testament, it is important to determine if the fulfillment was for literal Israel or whether it applies to the Israel of God in the last days, the 144,000, or perhaps both
 - To know whether we have the true historical event for the fulfillment of a prophecy: If you find every word of the prophecy (after the figures are understood) is literally fulfilled, then you may know that your history is the true event. But if one word lacks a fulfillment, then you must look for another event, or wait its future development. For God takes care that history and prophecy doth agree, so that the true, believing children of God may never be ashamed. Psalms 21:5; Isaiah 14:17-19; 1 Peter 2:6; Revelation 17:17; Acts 3:18 (Miller's rule #13)




The 144,000 are a Distinct Group Among the Redeemed

The 144,000 make-up the first [firstfruits] of Jesus' two flocks:




- Revelation 14:4 "These are they which were not defiled with women; for they are virgins. These are they which follow the Lamb whithersoever he goeth. These were redeemed from among men, [being] the firstfruits unto God and to the Lamb."
- John 11:52 "And not for that nation only, but that also he should gather together in one the children of God that were scattered abroad."
- Zechariah 9:16 "And the LORD their God shall save them in that day as the flock of his people: for they [shall be as] the stones of a crown, lifted as an ensign upon his land."
- Malachi 3:14-18 those who keep God's ordinances and mourn for the abominations committed in Israel will be numbered as jewels by Jesus
- Isaiah 56:8 "The Lord GOD which gathereth the outcasts of Israel saith, Yet will I gather [others] to him, beside those that are gathered unto him."
- Ezekiel 8, 9 those in Israel (Adventism) that sigh and cry for the abominations committed in the midst (9:4)


